

FUNDRAISING OPPORTUNITY WITH A VIRTUAL SCREENING:

We are now offering a virtual screening of our documentary as a fundraising effort for your organization. It does not require any fee or payment on your part. It works like this:

- on the Vimeo VOD platform, we would set up the virtual screening for a period of time anywhere from 3 days to 7 days (it can be any length of time, your choice).
- you decide how much you would like to make the donation for viewing the film (\$5, \$10, \$20 - it can be whatever you decide).
- once the viewer makes their donation, they have 48 hours or 72 hours (it can be any length of time) to view the film.
- you could also set up a Zoom chat at the end of the event window to have a discussion with your viewers (again your choice and this would be up to you to set up and handle).
- we would set up the virtual screening on Vimeo VOD with information about your organization and info about your event (see sample of a previous event below).
- we would then split the proceeds with you. No money out of your pocket at all.
